

ARMSTRONG TRAILS



Armstrong Trails invites residents and visitors alike to slow down and get outside in a safe, peaceful setting. Ideal for biking, walking, jogging, birdwatching, fitness, and in the winter, cross-country skiing. Spanning 52.5 miles along the eastern bank of the Allegheny River and the northern bank of the Kiskiminetas River, the flat, crushed-limestone trail weaves together the communities of East Brady, Kittanning, Ford City, and Leechburg while immersing users in the natural beauty of the Allegheny River Valley. Armstrong Trails is the critical link to the emerging 270-mile Erie to Pittsburgh Trail and the 214-mile PA Wilds Trail. Just five miles from the East Brady trailhead, Armstrong Trails connects to the 51-mile Redbank Valley Trails.

ALLEGHENY RIVER PA'S 2017 & 2024 RIVER OF THE YEAR

The Wild and Scenic Allegheny River curves in a broad loop around East Brady, bordered by steep, forested banks. This scenic stretch supports motorboats, kayaks, and canoes and is popular with anglers, boaters, and water skiers. A growing population of bald eagles and other wildlife call the area home, and a large public boat ramp and dock are located nearby in Brady's Bend.

Local Attractions

GRAHAM SPORTS COMPLEX

Located off Verner Street, the complex provides a playground for children, basketball court and skateboard park. Graham Field provides space for football, soccer, softball, and baseball or other large outdoor events. It is located adjacent to Armstrong Trails and Riverfront Park.

EAST BRADY RIVERFRONT PARK

Located off Waterway Lane, the park offers kayak access to the Allegheny River, a large pavilion, tables for picnicking and a beautiful view of the Allegheny River.

EAST BRADY VETERANS' MEMORIAL PARK

Located at the corner of Kelly's Way and First Street, The Park was dedicated August 13, 1994 honoring East Brady area veterans.

SCENIC BRADY'S BEND AT THE OVERLOOK

Located two miles east of East Brady, the overlook provides a spectacular 1,500 foot panoramic view of the bend in the Allegheny River. In the fall, the view is especially beautiful. Bring your camera!

BRADY'S BEND FISH AND BOAT COMMISSION LAUNCH

Located just off the Sergeant Carl F. Curran Bridge at 218 Seybertown Rd., this public launch provides access to the Allegheny River for water activities including motor boating, kayaking, canoeing, jet skiing, fishing and more.

THE BRADY'S BEND SPORTS COMPLEX

Located adjacent to the Brady's Bend Twp. Municipal Building on SR 68 this complex provides outdoor basketball, hockey, tennis and pickleball courts.

BRADY'S BEND FLOOD MEMORIAL PICNIC AREA

Located along SR 68 this picnic area was built by the community in memory of residents lost in the Flood of 1980. There is a handicapped accessible pavilion with tables and a grill.

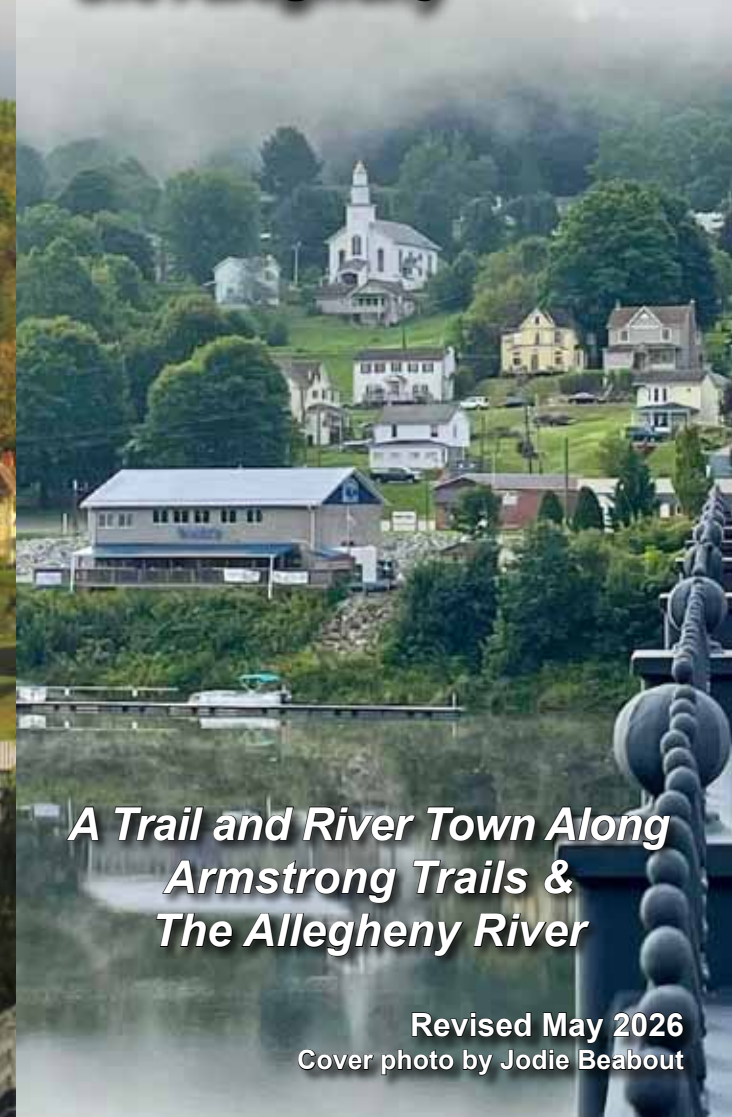

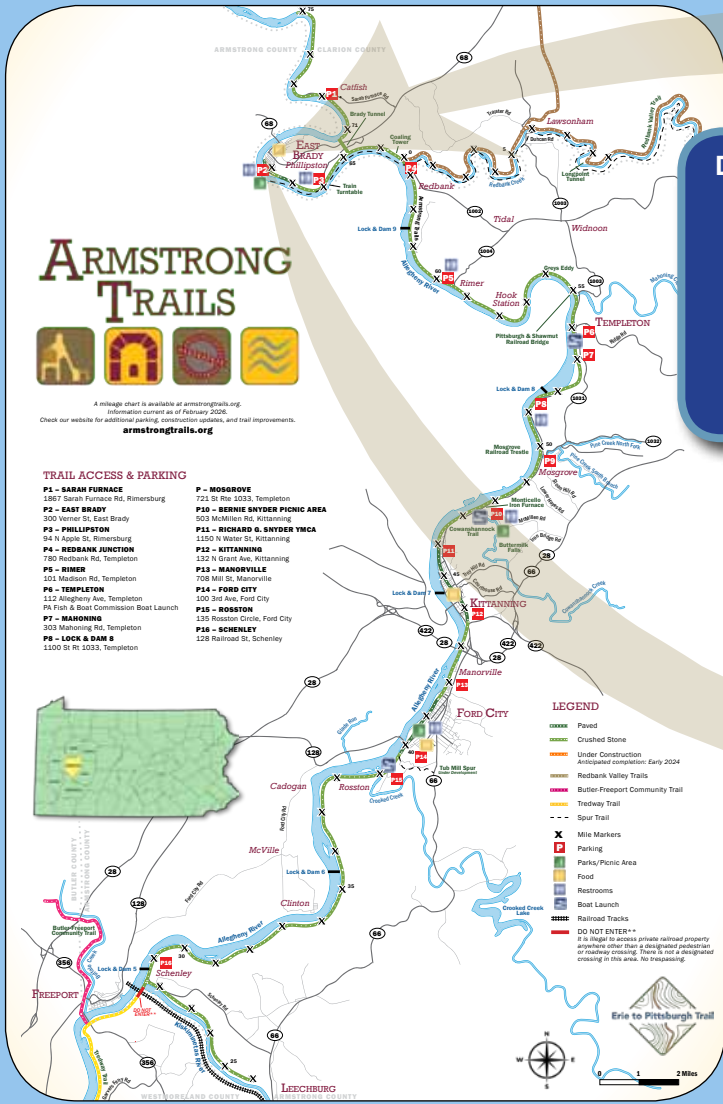
